



Background

- National sample of 1001 seniors (those over 65 years of age) with drug coverage
 - Medicare Part D and Medicare Advantage participants combined as Medicare Rx
 - Seniors with other Rx coverage
- Interviewed by telephone 10/25 10/31/07
- Margin of error +/- 3.1%

All in all, have your experiences in using your (part D plan) been very positive, somewhat positive, very negative, or somewhat negative?



Most seniors report Medicare Rx is working for them


My Medicare plan is working for me and I am happy I signed up. Do you agree or disagree with this statement.

Whether or not you signed up for it yourself, how helpful do you think Medicare's prescription drug coverage is for the typical person on Medicare?




Overall seniors are very satisfied with their drug coverage

coverage


Satisfaction levels are nearly as high as for all seniors with drug coverage




Seniors are getting the medicines they need




Seniors satisfied with the number of drugs covered by their plan




Seniors are able to get their prescriptions filled

Seniors are getting answers to their questions




Seniors find their insurance plan easy to use




Seniors satisfied with the customer service provided by their plans



Seniors on Medicare Rx are saving money




Seniors on Medicare Rx find their premiums and co-pays affordable



Most seniors with Medicare Part D think they made a good plan choice


Do you feel you made a good choice in selecting your Medicare drug plan, or do you think you would have been better off with a different plan?



Most seniors with Medicare Rx are aware of open enrollment


- 85% of Medicare Rx participants are aware of the open enrollment period from 11/15 to 12/31
 - Of these 85% (72% of total) are aware plans can change the drugs covered and co-pay amounts.
- 79% of Medicare Rx participants believe they have the information they need to decide which type of coverage is best for them.

Few seniors with Medicare Rx plan to compare options



Seniors with Medicare Rx are aware of financial assistance to low income seniors

Medicare and Social Security have programs like Extra Help to provide financial assistance to low income seniors to help them pay for part of their monthly premiums, deductibles and co-pays for prescription drug coverage. Were you aware of these financial assistance programs or not? (Among seniors with Medicare Rx)



Conclusions

- Positive experience with Medicare Rx plans is high and rising
 - Those with *very positive* experience increased by 12 percentage points
- Overall satisfaction with Medicare Rx is high
- Medicare Rx plans are viewed as saving money and being affordable
- Awareness of open enrollment period is high
 - But few with Medicare Rx plan to compare options
- Awareness of financial assistance to low income seniors is good but has room for growth
